



Fayetteville Public Schools' Hall of Honor Guidelines for Eligibility and Selection

Mission Statement:

The Hall of Honor commemorates educators, alumni, and friends who have demonstrated extraordinary Fidelity, Honor, and Service to the Fayetteville Public Schools and our community.

Objective:

To provide role models for our students, to create excitement about education, and to honor educators, former students and friends of public education in Fayetteville.

1. Alumni/Student:

Must have attended or graduated from the Fayetteville School District. The nomination must be made ten (10) years or more from date of attendance or graduation of the candidate. Must have attended or graduated from the Fayetteville School District. The Hall of Honor award is given to a person who has made outstanding contributions in one or more of the following areas:

- Positive role models for the students of the Fayetteville School District.
- Contribute in an exemplary manner to humanitarian efforts, community service, or public service at the local, state or national level.
- Achieve notable success through leadership, character, and service in their profession.
- Demonstrate exceptional service in support of the advancement and continued excellence of the Fayetteville School District.

2. Educator/Employee:

Must have retired or resigned from the Fayetteville School District for three (3) or more years before being considered for nomination. Must have taught, worked or contributed service to the Fayetteville School District for ten (10) years or more. The Hall of Honor award is given to a person who has made outstanding contributions in one or more of the following areas:

- A positive and outstanding role model: respected by students, staff and/or parents.
- Inspired and challenged students to succeed and/or fostered high quality performance from students.
- A person of uncommon dedication, going beyond the call of duty to assist students, staff and/or parents.
- Added to the field of education or to their community through their service.

3. Fayetteville Public Schools Friend:

The Hall of Honor award is given to a Friend of the Fayetteville Public Schools who has made outstanding contributions in one or more of the following ways:

- An exceptional patron of the Fayetteville Public Schools through contributed time, volunteerism, or resources for the betterment of the school district.
- Demonstrated leadership, character, and service to the community and a positive role model for community members and students of the Fayetteville Public Schools.
- Known for his/her contributions to the betterment of the community, state or country.

Hall of Honor Inductee nominations may be considered *posthumously*, this award is given only when outstanding merit or significant achievement are deemed necessary to be recognized.

Each year the FHS Student Council may submit a *Student Choice Award*, this award is given only when outstanding merit or significant achievement are deemed necessary to be recognized.

Nominations of individuals who are not selected to the Hall of Honor will remain for consideration as potential nominees for five (5) years after the original date of nomination.
