Need (15 points)

What need, problem, gap or opportunity was identified that will be addressed through this grant?

Holt's need for a structured bike program was met through Outride's Riding for Focus program. However, once Holt received the new bikes, the need arose for proper and continual bike maintenance because professionals recommend bikes be serviced at minimum once every two weeks but ideally once a week. In order to prolong the life of our bikes as well as support the number of students utilizing the bikes daily, we need suitable tools. If tools are received, students will have the incredible opportunity to participate in a program to learn vo-tech skills through basic and advanced bike maintenance.

Program Description (25 points)

The Husky Cycle Shop will be a program that provides students with ample hands-on learning opportunities as well as future opportunities through bicycle upkeep. These opportunities include learning basic bike maintenance skills, enriching their learning through attending advanced maintenance workshops taught by community cycling and bike professionals, upkeeping a fleet of bikes so both current and future students can participate in the Riding for Focus program, exploring other vo-tech careers and learning pathways available in junior high and high school, and creating potential future job opportunities with local and regional bike shops. This program will also address the needs of kinesthetic learners by providing hands-on experiences in basic mechanical engineering.

Steps for implementation:

1. Partner with Lewis and Clark Outfitters to acquire proper tools and equipment as well as schedule future workshops
2. Coordinate training for PE coaches
3. Prepare current bike space
4. Utilize social media to promote the Husky Cycle Shop
5. Introduce each PE class to the cycle shop
6. Train students during PE classes in basic maintenance skills
7. Begin Riding for Focus program
8. Provide weekly opportunities for students to maintain fleet of bikes

The Husky Cycle Shop has multiple expected outcomes, all of which greatly benefit students. These outcomes for students include graduating Holt with skills for personal bike maintenance, engaging in a unique learning experience, formulating a plan for future vo-tech learning opportunities at the junior high and high school level, student-led learning and teaching of mechanical engineering, participating in local events and experiences to apply their skills, and potential job and career opportunities when of age. As well as utilization of the bikes promotes overall wellness for our students including: reduced stress, increased cardiovascular stamina, improved mindset, and a fun way to increase exercise. The Husky Cycle Shop is vital for the continued successful implementation of our bike program.
