Educator/Employee Eligibility

Must have retired or resigned from the Fayetteville School District for three (3) or more years before being considered for nomination. Must have taught, worked, or contributed service to the Fayetteville School District for ten (10) years or more.

Criteria (one OR more)

- A positive and outstanding role model: respected by students, staff, and/or parents.
- Inspired and challenged students to succeed and/or fostered high-quality performance from students.
- Uncommon dedication, going beyond the call of duty to assist students, staff, and/or parents.
- Added to the field of education or their community through their service.
